# New Family Daycare Services

A long term strategic priority of the NEWROC has been to support member Councils in the establishment of childcare where there is no local service. Childcare is a significant enabler for workforce participation, respite and community service for parents, families and caregivers.

The NEWROC has recently supported the Shires and communities of Koorda and Wyalkatchem in the establishment of two new family day care services, in partnership with the Shire of Williams.

These two new services complement existing childcare services in Mukinbudin, Dowerin, Bencubbin and Beacon.

## Town Team Funding

The collaboration between Town Team Movement and the NEWROC resulted in an impressive 'Dowerin Do Over' earlier this year. It also encouraged the establishment of a Dowerin Town Team —

Dowerin This Together. The group was recently successful in securing RAC funding for a transformation of the façade of the Tin Dog General Store where future community activities will be held.

#### **Meet the Minister**

A NEWROC delegation met with the Hon John Carey MLA; Minister for Local Government and Housing at Dumas House September. early purpose of the meeting was to demonstrate our interest in forming a regional subsidiary to help member Councils achieve the groups energy vision, as well as provide feedback on the shortage quality accessible accommodation for the regional workforce.
